

## IMPORTANT DETAILS ABOUT YOUR INSTALLATION OF SCOTCH TINT FILM AND/OR SCOTCH SHIELD

Dear Customer:

Congratulations! You have just purchased the finest window film product available. 3M has devoted over 50 years to the development and improvement of Scotchshield Ultra Safety and Security Film and Scotchtint Sun Control Films so that today you may enjoy the sun without its harmful effects and increased protection from broken glass.

As with all products containing an adhesive system, a drying time is necessary for the proper adhesion to the window. During this process, some changes may be observed as outlined below. They are normal and should be expected to occur. Listed below, by way of recap, are the points covered by our installers:

- Drying time is dependent on weather conditions and the season of installation. Drying time may range from 30 to 60 days. Please do not wash your windows during this period.
- Warmer days or full sunny conditions will speed the drying process.
- Any haze, milky appearance, or bubbles you may see is simply water under the film. You will see less and less of this as the day's pass.
- Small dust particles or points are inevitable with any applied film. These points, sometimes viewed as small bubbles are very tiny bits of dust or debris that are always present in the air. They will not affect your normal viewing or film performance.
- A border of 1-2mm is a requirement of the application according to 3M standards.
- Cleaning should be done using non harsh window cleaning solution such as Windex and non-abrasive paper towels such as Bounty. We use and recommend a mild solution of dish soap or baby shampoo (4-5 drops/gallon) in water and a good quality squeegee.

NOTE: Sometimes a customer feels that they see a defect in the film when it is, in fact, in the glass. It is quite natural that one should look closely at a new purchase. We follow the Visual Standards set by 3M which states imperfections should not be visible when viewing the glass from six feet away under normal day lit conditions. This is the manner in which we normally look through a window and the way in which you should observe your new Scotchshield or Scotchtint Window Film—*looking through it, not at it.*

We and 3M hope you will enjoy your new installation and the many benefits from its presence on your windows.
